### Place of the conference

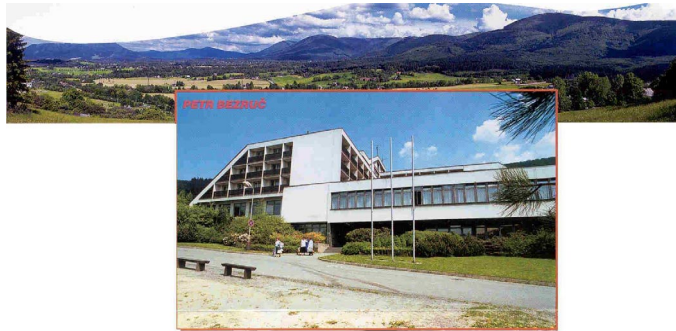
