Abstract: The abstract must not exceed 150 words (9 pt.)

Key words: List of 4 - 5 key words, one line only (9 pt).

**1 Introduction: general instructions
(11 pt, bold)**

The contribution will be converted from the author's MS-Word (XP/2003) file manuscript prepared according to these instructions. The manuscript must be prepared on A4-format (210 x 297 mm). This file must be sent via E-mail to: iccc@automation.ucv.ro, or uploaded via the ICCC 2008 web information system.

The length of the paper is 4 (four) pages (mandatory). The paper should be prepared by means of any word processor MS-WORD XP/2003, with a text font Times New Roman. Required page format A4 (210 x 297 mm). Margins: top 57 mm, bottom 50 mm, left: 40 mm and right 40 mm. On the first page, the top margin must be 33 mm + 57 mm = 90 mm, for adding the conference heading. The width of the typeset area is 130 mm and the length is 190 mm. The paper text must be written in two columns (column width 62 mm, space between columns 6 mm). The first chapter title has to be within the spaces before a paragraph (Style Name "First Chapter").

The paper must be written in English only. The titles of all main **Sections**, **Acknowledgement** and **References** must be typed starting from the left margin of the page in bold face using 11 pt. fonts. The words **Abstract**,

Key words and the titles of all **Subsections** must be typed starting from the left margin of the page in bold face in the same font as the text of the paper (9 pt). For the main text Times New Roman 9 pt size font is required. Paragraphs must have approximately 5 mm indent. The references should be given in square brackets, for example [Farana 2001, Smutný 2001].

1.1 Further information (9 pt, bold)

The title of the paper, the names of the authors and the addresses must be centred between the left and right text margin. The title must be placed immediately below the top margin of the first page (that is 33 mm + 57 mm = 90 mm) and typeset in bold face 11 pt size. Subsequently, you must skip 9pt and print the name(s) of the author(s) in bold face and the address(es) in normal face. Then skip 9pt and print the abstract. Identical authors' addresses should be omitted. The following address form is required:

First line/row: Institute or Department

Second line: Name of Company or University

Third line: City, Country, E-mail address

1.2 Figures, tables and equations

All figures and tables must be included in the MS-Word file of the paper and must be

centred. Figures or pictures must be included to the text of paper as conjugate objects (for example Object – Microsoft Word Picture). The number and title of a figure (typed using 9 pt. fonts) should be placed under an illustration and centred, with respect to it, only black-and-white figures and tables are allowed.

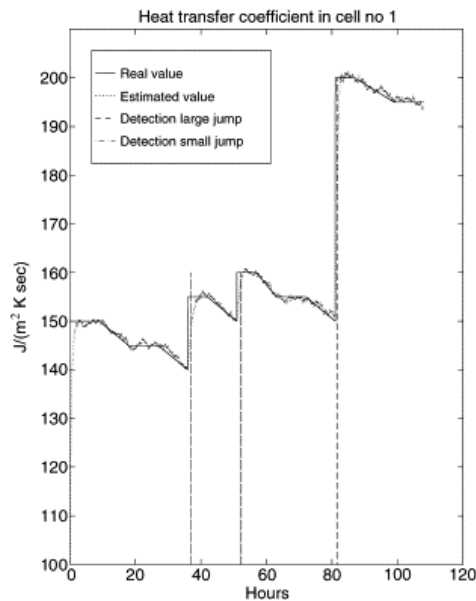


Fig. X. Title of figure (9 pt.)

The figures must be referred as Fig. X or Figs. X-Y.

Equations are centrally justified and numbered consecutively from (1) upwards. Number must be justified to the right text margin.

$$M_s = M_m \cdot \sin(\varphi) \quad (1)$$

where: M_s – actual size, M_m – maximal size, φ – gradient.

Text sizes are based on the main size 9pt, parameters of MS Word (MS Equation) formula formatting are:

- size – 9pt,
- lower/upper index – 60 %,
- lower/upper subindex – 40 %,
- symbol – 120 %,
- subsymbol – 100 %.

Tables need to be centred, and their number

should be placed above, centred.

2 Paper text

Paper text must be written in two columns (column width 62 mm, space between columns 6 mm). If you need to include bigger pictures, tables etc., it is recommended to place them at the end of page where these are referred (changing the columns to one column).

Acknowledgement

Write acknowledgement, if needed, at the end of your paper, before references. The chapter title has to be without number.
